New Ways to Give!

Whether we like it or not, the world is constantly changing, and in an effort to keep up with the pace of modern life we have upgraded the ways in which you can donate your money to Vineville Baptist. For some of you, what I am about to say below will make absolutely no sense whatsoever. But for others of you, the changes we have made in our giving opportunities are long overdue.

First, let me note the ways you can already give to the church. You can always give us cash. Cash is good. Just make sure that if you give cash you put your name on the envelope so our financial secretary will know to whom to credit the gift.

You can make your donation by check, simply making the check payable to Vineville Baptist Church. I suspect you already knew that.

But you might not know that you can also donate to the church through Bill Pay at your bank. That is to say, you can give to the church online through the internet banking option provided by your bank. All you would need to do is add Vineville Baptist Church as a payee for an automatic deduction from your bank account. You can set up your bill pay schedule as a single or ongoing online offering to the church. If you utilize this option, there is no cost to the church.

However, we have now made available to you the option of paying by accessing our website (www.vinevillebaptistchurch.org). There is a link at the top of our webpage that says "Give Online." You will need to provide your email address to register for this option. For many of you, donating through online giving has become your new normal. I would add however, that if you choose this option the church will incur bank service fees. That is to say, if you choose to use a credit card or debit card, the church will be charged a bank fee that is approximately 3% of the total gift. So, if you donate \$100 through online giving, approximately \$3 will go to the bank. If you use your checking account for online giving the church is charged a smaller fee, approximately 1% of the total gift.

There is yet another option. You can donate to the church through your smartphone. Using the QR reader on your smart phone you will need to scan our QR code, which is located on our church bulletin. This will link you directly to our website to donate through the online option that I described above. As with the online option, the church will incur bank fees, approximately 3% if using your credit or debit card, 1% if using your bank account.

However you give, please be conscientious in your stewardship, particularly during the summer months, when our vacation schedules often take us away from church. Churches traditionally become "cash poor" during the summer, and Vineville is no exception to this rule. But our expenses do not take the summer off, even if we do! So be sure to be conscientious in your stewardship during this summer period.

Don't forget that we will enjoy a potluck dinner this Wednesday. I will prepare the main course, grilled pork loin, but I invite you to bring the remainder of the meal. We will also honor our students, teachers and administrators as they prepare (ugh) for going back to school. We will be pledging to them our prayers and support as they embark on a new educational year.

Remember also that next Sunday, July 29, all of the Sunday School classes will gather in the gym for a joint lesson. A light breakfast will be served, and Russell Honeycutt will be delivering the lesson that morning.

On Wednesday, August 1, the Puerto Rico Mission Team will be sharing testimonials and anecdotes from their recent trip in June. I know you will want to be in attendance. Our youth and children will be sharing some of their summer church experiences on the next Wednesday, August 8.
